1. The treasurer's report stated there is \$37,923.47 in the general fund and \$36,139.41 in the Bryn Mawr Day account.
2. Scott Zelov informed us that 8 pairs of Big Belly Trash Receptacles are coming to Bryn Mawr. They are equipped with wireless communication to notify the township when they need to be emptied. It is the business that are responsible to keep their sidewalks clean and weed free. Opening in September are Grove 121, Marbles Restaurant and Kindred. Something Different by Erick is open. Robertson Florist and Arrowroot have change locations.
3. Sue Graham updated us on Bryn Mawr Day. Volunteers are needed for Sunday September 2nd to help put "NO PARKING" signs up in the parking lot. Gold vendor spots are sold out but other sponsorships are still available. Local stores should be promoting Bryn Mawr Day on their social media sites. Bryn Mawr Rotary, the Boy Scouts and Horizon Church have all volunteered to help on the 8th. The tour bus is in place and once again Bobbie McElroy will be giving the tour.
4. We are working on the 2019 Bryn Mawr Folded Map.
5. Bryn Mawr Beautiful needs someone with a water tank truck to water the pole planters. On August 11th Ben Katz will be repairing the shed at Ludington Library for his Eagle Scout Project. Horizon Church has done a lot of gardening and put the rocks around the trees throughout Bryn Mawr.
6. Villanova is looking for projects for their Day of Service. There was a cookout at Home Properties at the beginning of the year to stress being a good community member. Local residents and law enforcement were invited. The first week in November will be Restaurant Week in Bryn Mawr and Wayne.
