NOVEMBER 18, 2021

- T. Rubin welcomed everyone to the meeting and gave a brief overview of the holiday lights going up. He noted the Bryn Mawr Night is for shopping and eating and Bryn Mawr Day is more a community event.
- H. Ammans is from Villanova and is replacing Laura. Students and community are back on campus. The vaccination rate is at 98%. Unvaccinated people need to submit to biweekly testing. She advised us that there will be a night time market held on campus at Villanova and will forward more information as it becomes available.
- E. Persson reported there is an agreement for Clover Market before the township. The Farm to City Market will go before the commissioners at the 12/8/21 meeting to agree on a cost and how often.
- C. Doyle reported he is the Assistant Director of Building and Planning and started in April. He is very interested in Bryn Mawr and looking to assist in reinvigorating the area with new development in coordination with land owners and businesses as well as promote business.
- C. Fish reported that he mentioned “Shop and Dine Main Line” to the Main Line Chamber of Commerce through the holidays. He reported that his business consists of a lot of changing watch batteries. The exercise studio next door fills the parking lots and spaces with employees and no where for customers to park. There is a need to enforce the 2 hour limit for parking. C. Doyle will speak to Jerry Adams, new Parking Director about this.
- Free Saturday parking was discussed and the dates would be 12/4, 12/11 and 12/18. Flyers can be made.
- C. Felton reported on the success of Bryn Mawr Night and wants to look into doing more events. She is working with Main Line Art Center to help promote this event.

- S. Zelov reported that he won reelection in Ward 10. Pennswood Bridge will be opening soon. There will be street cleaning and dates for the cut-in will be provided. Tin Lizard is closed. There will be utility work done on Rt. 30 by PECO during the day..
