

BMBA BOARD MEETING MINUTES
November 9, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Kathy Bogosian and the following items discussed:

- There is \$29,518.36 in the BMBA general fund and \$23,962.36 in the BMDay account. The Camera Shop gives a great price on BMDay printing and produces a great product. We are pursuing investment options to “hold” holiday light money.
- Sidewalk cleaning by Crawford Landscaping is scheduled for Sunday, November 19th, weather permitting. We will try to coordinate it with the township street cleaning.
- Carol Smith informed us that the Furniture Consignment store is now open. Marbles restaurant is coming along. An ice cream shop is looking to open near the BM Film Institute. First Choice restaurant is almost open. The Boy Scouts are looking for potential Eagle Scout projects, maybe rebuild the shed at Ludington Library.
- Scott Zelov told us that Kelly's is looking into having planters at their restaurant, however, there is a question concerning the amount of sidewalk space that is available. 2017 was the best season yet for the Farmers Market and they have signed a contract for the 2018 season. There was another meeting between Radnor Township, Home Properties and Villanova University that was productive. On November 11th, from 8:00am to 3:00pm, County Line Road will be closed for work being done at Bryn Mawr Hospital. The holiday lights are up and most are on. Notify Dick Cuff with the pole number and issue of any snowflake and he will notify Rileighs.
- Due to a lack of effort on selling space in the newspaper's Holiday issue with Ardmore, BMBA is pulling out. First Friday will take place at the gazebo at Ludington Library from 7pm to 8pm. There will be hot chocolate and cookies, caroling, and an appearance by Santa and Mrs. Clause. The festivities continue on Saturday December 2nd at 9am with Santa at Bryn Mawr Trust where there will also be a BMBA members breakfast. From 10am to 12pm, there will be free horse and wagon rides at the Gazebo. The Wilson Vocal Academy Singers, Bryn Mawr College's Looney Tunes, Bryn Mawr Acapella Group and Cool Beans Music will provide entertainment.
